Tom Reveley is a technology leader, cyber security speaker and independent adviser with more than 20 years of experience dealing with the decisions businesses make before, during and after things go wrong.

His career began in IT support at Royal Bank of Scotland and developed through multi-site technology roles in commercial environments including Mercedes, Merlin Entertainments and Watling Tyres, where he worked as IT Manager. His work has included responsibility for business-critical systems, technology suppliers, budgets, cyber security and incidents.

In 2019, Tom founded IT Manager Services Ltd. He now works directly with business owners and leadership teams as a Fractional CTO and independent adviser, helping them question technology spending, understand cyber security and AI risk, and retain responsibility when technology is outsourced.

Tom is a Chartered IT Professional (CITP), a Fellow of BCS, The Chartered Institute for IT (FBCS), and the author of Digital Hostage: Email Under Siege. He is also a judge at the UK IT Industry Awards 2026.
